Your Mission: You are to create a 3-9 slide comic strip, using Google Slides. These slides will retell a scene in your book.

You must include (use this as a checklist before you hand your work into Google Classroom):

- Captions:** underneath each slide will be a short caption to help the reader understand the picture. The caption must be related to the scene and the book.
- Characters:** the main characters of your novel must be clearly the main characters in your comic strip. The action and dialogue in your comic strip must match the action and dialogue in the novel.
- Setting:** The setting of your slide is the setting of your novel.
- Edit with a partner**
- Write Up:** *compare and explain*, in paragraph form, on the last slide (or two depending on how much you write) to be handed into Google Classroom, *the effectiveness of the novel and the comic strip for audience and purpose. In other words - do you think your book works better as a graphic novel or just a regular novel. If your book was already a graphic novel, do you think it could work as a regular novel?*
