Pre-Research Question: You must set two goals for the research process or the bibliography

Post Research: Answer the following questions: Did you reach your goals? What did you learn about the research process? What did you learn about bibliographies?

Bibliography: document all the websites that you glean information from. You need to include:

- The name of the website
- The URL (you may copy and paste this)
- The date you accessed the website
